Satellite Forms V6.0.1 was released this week. The main benefits of this new release include:

- updated handheld runtime engines with many bug fixes for the PocketPC runtime, and a new PocketPC date picker
- improved online help file with scripting and API reference included, updated PDF manual
- updated the software and documentation to reflect the acquisition of Satellite Forms from Intellisync by Thacker Network Tech. Inc.
- corrected some minor bugs in the IDE, and added a new hotkey **F5** for the Handheld Download App & Tables function
